Call for papers

In recent years the media narratives have paid special attention to the role of document: it appears in media commemorations, it is central in representations of court cases, and it is starring in the new documentary and fictional forms. The document is, therefore, part of a set of textual strategies to create a realistic effect that could represent the heart of the "documentary style" itself. The document, which can be defined as the inscription of the facts, is presented as a multifaceted object that can manifest in audiovisual, visual or sound form.

The XVI Congress of the Spanish Association of Semiotics and V Congress of the Department of Audiovisual Communication and Advertising of the UPV/EHU proposes a general reflection on the role of the document in the various forms of contemporary textuality. Configured as a key element of the verification and authentication strategies of a discourse, the document is presented as an object of study with special semiotic interest which covers the problems of its discursive order and its different textual uses such as witness, testimony or proof.

Inevitably, any analysis of the document is connected with contemporary reflection on the file, essential, for instance, in understanding the increasingly important role of databases both in the discourse of social sciences and in the journalistic and media discourse. Moreover, the relevance of the document forms forwarded to a topic as sensitive as memory, whose role is key in the construction and invention of identities in a world at once globalized and hyperlocalized. From a more general perspective, the analysis of the document would represent, therefore, a description of the ways of telling the present time.

With all this, we invite to propose contributions that analyze both the construction of the document and its textual applications in all media narratives.
